Quote: “Sportsmanship means working together and not fighting,” Fourth Grade Student.

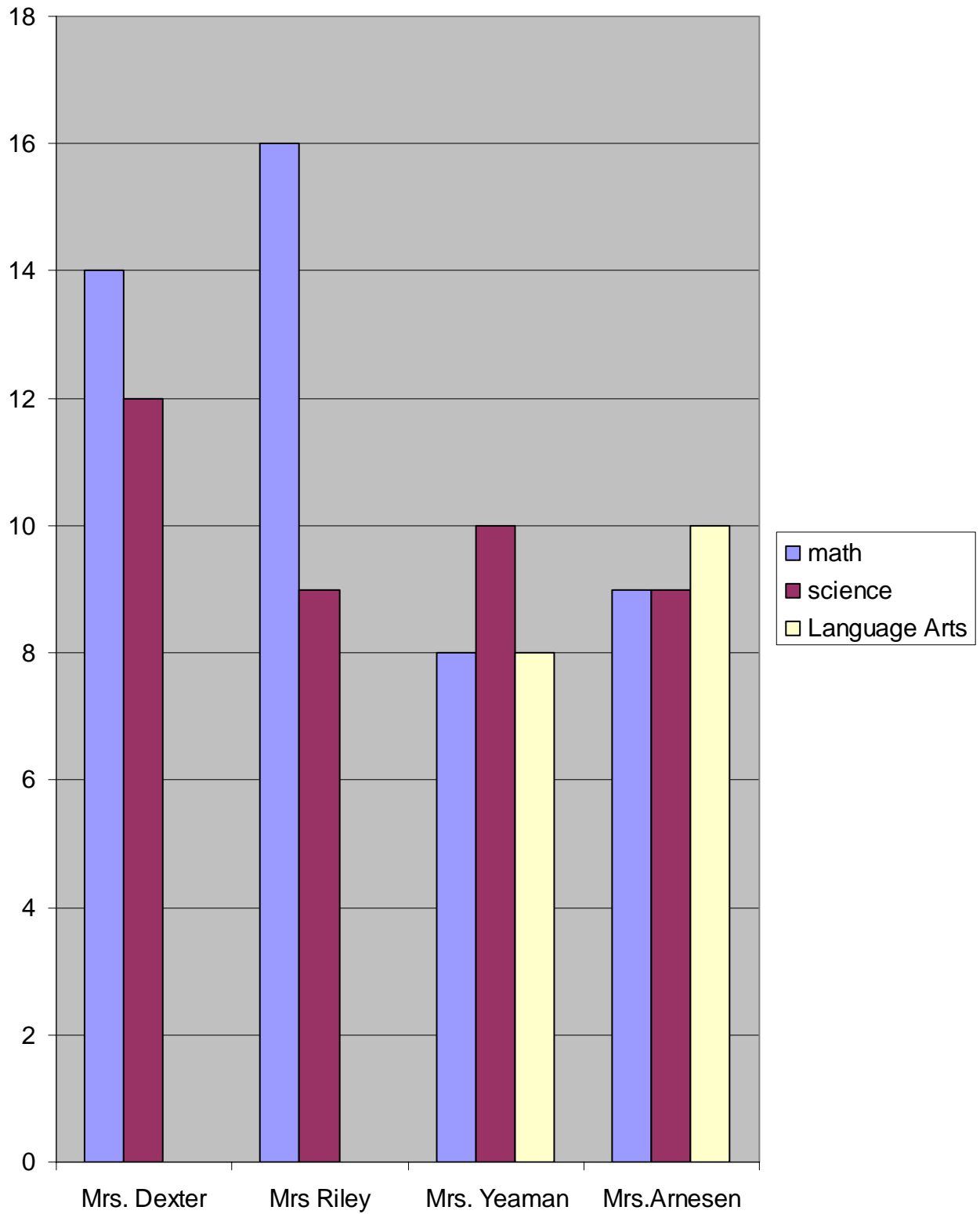
Quote: “Sportsmanship means to cooperate when you get out in a game and encourage others,” Fifth Grade Student.

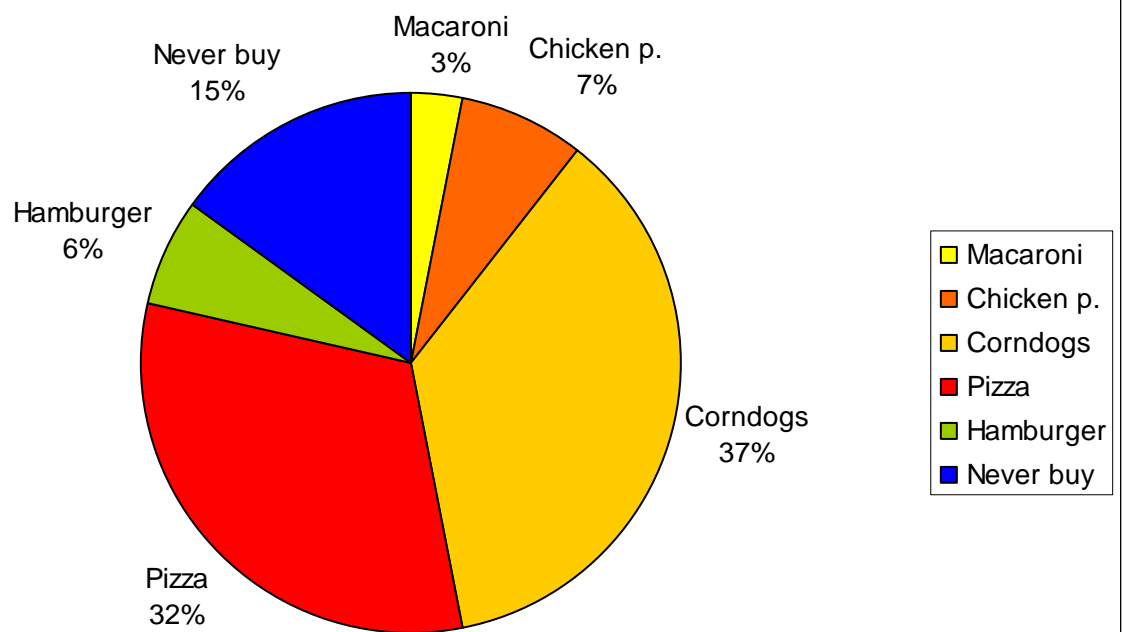

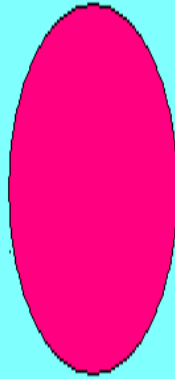

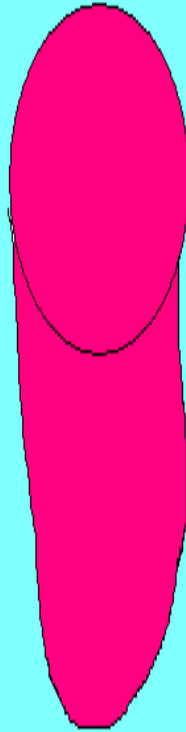
